What we know now (15 min)

- Data share information from DCPS survey
- RCC needs for planning questions
 - We have some discretion in building capacity
 - o DCPS charging us to try to bring back at least one class per grade level
 - There is flexibility in different grades using different models to bring students back.

- Some rooms are designated for furniture
- Have to consider non teaching staff or service providers
 - Sometimes 3-4 people per office space, are limited in that
- Capacity is roughly 20 classrooms
- Staffing capacity
 - Goes through HR
- Mayor is not going to set a metric for opening/closing
 - They are looking in and across schools
- No outside partnerships (on the table as possibility for adv 4)
 - Means no aftercare, Janney +, etc. for advisory 3
- Waiting to see what the model and staff will be before offering spots
- o Do we want an equal amount of teachers per grade?
 - Not necessarily
