

## Janney Elementary LSAT Meeting Minutes

### October 12, 2021

#### Notes:

- **Health & Safety Updates**
  - Asymptomatic testing going well (about 70% of students tested at least once this year so far); requires significant staff time, but doable; working through issues with parents accessing results
  - Not using MyMedBot data to inform testing pool (62 reported negative tests in the last 7 days out of 525 responses);
  - Hard for little ones to produce enough saliva for tests, so nasal swab would be preferred
  - Would be helpful if we could add teachers for asymptomatic testing; this may be possible now with recent policy changes
- **School Goals Follow-Up**
  - Initial reading and math assessments completed
  - Acceleration Academy programs started for grades 3-5; students in grades 1-2 will be added in Cycle 2 (\$40,000 in stimulus funds)
- **Facilities Updates**
  - Non-classroom spaces now have HEPA filters, ordered by school
  - Still waiting on HVAC repairs -- wrong part was ordered; but classrooms not as hot, so less concern; isolated to offices on 2nd and 3rd floor atrium area
  - Still working through issues with playground; will approach PTA executive board with proposal for potential use of funds for repairs
- **Behavior & Discipline Policy**
  - Student support team working to support more behavior issues and to develop a family-facing version of Janney's policy/approach/plan
  - Need to loop in JAC and make sure they know what to look out for and are on board with plan

- Still considering possibility of adding parent volunteers to lunch and recess; would require training and proper clearances
